- 1. Enrollment fee:** New student - \$155 per student to FCS; \$20 per student to FACTS
Returning student - \$155 per student to FCS; \$10 per student charged by FACTS

2. Choose a payment plan:

3. Fundraising Fee:

\$275.00 per child \$550.00 for family with more than 2 children.

If the fee is not raised with the CSP program, or paid by CSP turn-in day, the fee will be drafted on November 5. If sponsors are promised and they are not received by the end of December, the balance of the fundraising fee will be drafted on January 5.

- 4. Middle School/High School Wild's Fee (7-12):** \$170 per student. This fee is due the Thursday before the Wild's camp.

5. Incidental Fees: All fees are billed to your account on the 10th and drafted on the 20th of the month.

- Learning Center - 1 hr. a day - \$900 annually; 2 hrs. a day - \$1500 annually; 3 hrs. a day - \$1800 annually
- Music - private lesson fee -\$35/month drafted Sept. to May
- Sports fee - \$110 per sport
Fall sports drafted September, Winter sports drafted November;
- Afterschool - \$5 per day per child; drafted monthly
- PSAT fee (10th and 11th grades) - \$25; drafted October
- Achievement testing fee - \$20 per child; drafted January
- Yearbook - \$45 per student (Due October)
- HS Lab fees (science) - \$10 to \$25 per student;
Anatomy is \$50 per student; drafted January
- NSF funds fee - \$30; Late payment fee - \$20; drafted

Payment Policy

Accounts are billed on the 25th of the month; draft reminders are sent on the 1st of the month; tuition/fees are drafted on the 5th of the month; re-draft for failed payment, late fees and NSF fees will be drafted on the 20th of the month. 12-month plans begin in June. Single payments are due no later than August 15. Accounts that are delinquent/unpaid can be subject to financial suspension/record and transcript hold/graduation non-participation. Financial suspension means that a student will be held out of school until the account is brought current. Accounts/payments will be managed and processed through a third-party tuition management program called Facts by bank draft. If a guarantor fails to pay any tuition/fees, Faith Christian School has a right to turn over guarantor to a third-party collection agency, third-party arbitration or a lien will be placed on the guarantor's personal property in order to collect the unpaid tuition/fees.

Scholarship Information

- Scholarships are based on the \$4,359 tuition rate plus fees per child.
- ESEF scholarship is an in-house scholarship that is offered to multi-child families.
- The North Carolina Opportunity Scholarship is a scholarship that can be received through the state of North Carolina. It is a needs-based scholarship based on income. You may apply at www.ncseaa.edu/OSG.htm This scholarship can cover the majority of the cost of tuition and fees. FCS has no control over who receives this scholarship.
- The CSA scholarship is a local scholarship organization. It is a needs-based scholarship evaluated by a family's income that covers a partial amount of the tuition and fees. Information on this scholarship can be found on the school's website. CSA is not administrated by Faith Christian School. CSA processes applications in the spring.
- A student can only have one scholarship applied to his/her account.
- Acceptance of a scholarship does not guarantee enrollment in FCS.
- In the event that an outside scholarship fails to cover the balance, the parents are responsible for the tuition and fees.
- Scholarships can be lost for disciplinary issues or failure to pay tuition/fees to school.
- Parents are responsible for any tuition/fees not paid by scholarships.
